

HOLY CROSS HIGH SCHOOL ANNOUNCES STAFF CHANGES

Holy Cross High School announces two leadership changes for the upcoming 2019-2020 school year.



[LOUISVILLE, KY-APRIL 15] —Beginning in the 2019-2020 school year Jody Thornsberry will serve as the school's Assistant Principal. Thornsberry began his tenure at Holy Cross in the Admissions and Advancement Department in 2003 and served in that position until 2005 when he became the school's Athletic Director. Thornsberry's 14 year career as Athletic Director includes the leadership of 9 state team titles and 27 state individual titles. He earned KHSAA Region 6 Athletic Director of the Year in 2012 and 2017. He currently serves as a member of the All "A" State Board, the Louisville Invitational Basketball Tournament Board, 6th Region Tournament Committee and the KHSAA 6th & 7th Region Policy Board. Thornsberry earned his Bachelor of Science in Education and his Master of Arts in Education from

Spalding University. He was also a member of the Men's Basketball Team at Spalding University. Thornsberry is a 1992 graduate of Holy Cross High School. He and his wife Carolyn have 3 children and are active members of St. Lawrence Parish.

Kent Foushee will serve as the school's next Athletic Director. Foushee has served as the school's Director of Admissions since 2008. Prior to joining the Holy Cross staff Foushee worked in various management positions for Enterprise Car Rental. He earned his Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration from Bellarmine University. Foushee was an Assistant Basketball Coach at Holy Cross from 2004-2016 before he took over as Varsity Head Coach in the 2017 season. He and his wife Natalie have 2 children and are members of St. Peter the Apostle Parish.

Jody Thornsberry will also take over the Holy Cross Boys' Basketball Program as Varsity Coach in the 2019-2020 season replacing Foushee in this position.

Jody Thornsberry commented, "I have truly enjoyed my years as Director of Athletics at Holy Cross and I am excited and honored for the opportunity to continue to serve Holy Cross in a different role. It has been a blessing for my family and I to be part of such a great community.
