

New Construction

Facilities Master Plan

The district facilities master plan shall be maintained and kept up to date. The plan shall reflect the short-and-long term educational programming needs of the students based on the district educational goals. To assist in the accurate assessment of these needs, the plan shall include an identification of social, economic and political factors in the community together with district-level housing and funding issues which will ultimately affect the success and effectiveness of the district building and renovation program.

The plan shall incorporate population and enrollment projections based on a review of: 1) residential housing growth patterns; 2) kindergarten enrollments; and 3) student yield factors.

Concurrent with efforts to identify those demographic factors affecting school enrollment, the plan shall include an analysis of present and future design needs of the district together with an assessment of those qualitative factors which reflect the characteristics and capacity of each school facility.
