2. **Spiritual Assessment: Complete at home and print two copies.** Keep one for your files. How to access from CLHS website at www.clhs-tx.org:

- d. Scroll down to the bottom of the page and click on the link for “Spiritual Gifts” to start the assessment.
- e. Print the results immediately and email a copy to yourself.

3. **Assessments in Naviance Student**--located in the “About Me” section:

- a. Do What You Are (personality test)
- b. MI Advantage (Intelligence inventory; gives natural abilities)
- c. Learning Styles Inventory

- e. Career Interest Profiler
- f. Career Cluster Finder

1. **Junior College & Career Project** —This is a culmination of research done by evaluating the assessments completed. Students are shown how to find connections between these assessments to help them evaluate their natural gifts, interests, and personality. Within these assessments, careers/majors are listed. The goal is to find career(s) that pop up in multiple assessments and research at least one career to discover how this career fits with who they are as an individual. Is it a good fit? The research will continue with searching for colleges that offer the major that will lead towards that career path.
