- EBC – Basic structure for preparation/and reaction to emergencies/District Response Team/Review and update flow chart
- EEAG – Basic structure for transporting students in private vehicles/There were no changes/need to add a rule
- EDE – Basic structure for waste management and recycling
- EEAE-R – Basic structure for bus drivers' drug and alcohol program
- EF – Basic structure for district's food services (generic policy)
