BA in a related field required, MBA preferred. 10 to 15 years of related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience. Proven ability to complete accurate financial analysis. Demonstrated verbal and written communication skills. Proven ability to work as part of an interdisciplinary team with individuals from diverse backgrounds and programs. (Full-Time)

Safety Team Member Floor - is a working supervisor and reports to the Safety Team Supervisor of the assigned ASPIRA School of ASPIRA Inc. of Pennsylvania. The STM Floor Lead is responsible for enforcing ASPIRA and ASPIRA School procedural rules and regulations. Ensure the personal safety of children, staff, visitors, and property.
