Please understand there will be almost 1,000 registrations for these classes so many people unfortunately will not get a seat. Students were selected randomly. Students who applied but did not get the class are automatically on a waiting list, and if there is an opening, seats will be granted randomly ASAP. Class roster will be posted by Student id # no later than May 31st.
