

## **4-H camps still have room – sign up today!**

4-H offers several overnight summer camp opportunities for 2019! There is still room for Fayette County youth in all camps. Also, youth do not have to already be 4-H members to attend 4-H camp – camp can be their first 4-H activity!

The most popular 4-H summer camp is for 4-6<sup>th</sup> graders! Jr. 4-H Camp is \$300, and is set for July 8-12. It will be held at Ridley 4-H Center in Columbia, TN. Kids can enjoy fun activities like swimming, archery, rifle range, campfires, crafts, recreation time, and more! For families who register for Jr. Camp, there will be a Parent's Jr. 4-H camp meeting Monday, June 10<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 p.m. at the Extension office (302B Midland St., Somerville).

Jr. High Adventure Camp offers a similar experience to Jr. Camp except it is for older 4-H'ers, in grades 6-8<sup>th</sup>. It is also \$300, and is scheduled for July 1-4 at Ridley in Columbia, TN. It includes all the Jr. Camp activities, as well as opportunities such as hiking, canoeing, and team challenges.

Four specialty camps will be offered this summer: Outdoor Wildlife Leadership Service (O.W.L.S.), Electric, Line & Design, and Culinary U. O.W.L.S. Camp is set for May 28-May 31 in Dover, TN, and is \$190. If you are a 6-10<sup>th</sup> grader and love the outdoors, this is the camp for you! Electric Camp is held at UT Knoxville June 25-28 for \$290. Youth in 6-7<sup>th</sup> grades can enjoy an electrifying experience with Extension and electric utility professionals! Line and Design Camp is for 6-12<sup>th</sup> graders, and it will be held July 8-10 at UT Martin for \$120. Youth can learn to sew, design fun projects, create art, and more. Culinary U is a new camp this year for 9-12<sup>th</sup> graders! It will also be at UT Martin, on July 10-12. Youth will learn food handling and food safety, plus cook up some fun!
