Dear St. Elizabeth Families,

I hope you are enjoying the last few weeks of summer. The summer pace is always so refreshing as well as having time to spend with family and friends. I have a few reminders in regard to the new school year I want to share. New student orientation is on August 29th beginning at 8:30am in the gym. Students and parents should attend the orientation to meet their teachers and be provided with some basic information. Uniforms are not required. Returning students entering PK4 and Kindergarten students may attend as well if they are nervous. School opens for all students on Wednesday, September 4th which will be a half day, 12:15 dismissal. On the first day, our HSA will be welcoming parents for coffee and some treats at 7:50 in the cafeteria. Aftercare is not available on September 4th, but will be available on September 5th and 6th as they are full days. Aftercare ends at 6pm.

This year we will continue to sell milk, and snack cards will be available. Please be advised that students will have to bring lunch for the first 2 weeks as the lunch service will not start until the 16th. If this changes, we will contact you. Each day then you must pack your child's snack and lunch which includes drinks. Thank you for your understanding.

Students should return to school in their summer uniforms. Remember, this year black or blue sneakers are fine with the summer uniform as well as white or black socks. All student supply lists are on our website under resources. Summer work is there too if you haven't gotten to that yet. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me via email or through the office.

Students may be dropped off beginning at 7:25 each day when teachers are on duty. The first day we will line up outside weather permitting, and then go into the gym. Pre-K drop off remains at the Pre-K doors. There may be some construction as they are set to begin the new chapel, but it has not started yet. I will keep you informed.

We welcome our new students and families. We also have some new staff members. Mrs. Zepponi will be our Social Studies teacher in grades 6,7, and 8. We also welcome Ms. Traflet to grade 1 as Mrs. Camiolo prepares for the birth of her second child. Our new PK4 aide is Mrs. McNamee who will be with us in the mornings. This year Mrs. Leniw will be teaching 5th graders science.
