NOTICE OF LONG-TERM SUBSTITUTE TEACHING POSITION

SPECIAL EDUCATION TEACHER (MODERATE/SEVERE)

EXAMPLE OF DUTIES:

Plan and direct the activities of students with moderate to severe disabilities; work closely with parents, pupils, and staff members; keep necessary records, including Individual Education Plans (IEP) on each student as required; participate in the decisions regarding instructional materials and supplies; attend staff meetings at the school; provide guidance and direction to para-educators, health care support providers, and volunteers; schedule IEP's; and establish instructional goals and objectives for each student on the case load.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- A valid California Education Specialist Instruction Credential in Mod/Severe Disabilities.
- Must hold EL Authorization, CLAD, or BCLAD.

KNOWLEDGE/SKILLS:

- Knowledge of the needs of students with moderate to severe disabilities.
- Ability to establish and maintain positive working relationships with students, parents, and staff members.
- Ability to teach children in a positive and meaningful manner.
- Ability to keep accurate and current records.
- Ability to speak and write Spanish is desirable.
