	X	Game Day	Come join the fun! In this class, you will enjoy designing and building games with your friends. Each Friday will be a fun-filled day; the class will hold a game day, and you will be playing carnival games, arcade games, mini-golf or competing in obstacle courses that are designed by your classmates. Extraordinary fun for all!
X		Geo-City	Bring your own city to life in this Geo-City class. Given a budget and few criteria what kind of city could you build? Will your building be tall? Will your building be huge? Imagine the possibilities and take your city from blueprints, to electronic, to a complete scale model. You create, you design, and you build in this all inclusive Geo-City.
X		Exploring Pixel Art	If you like art, using computers, and drawing outside, then this class is for you!! In this class, we will be creating images that look like digital images!
