Dress Code:

Alpha (Mondays and Wednesdays): Academy Polo shirt, tan six-pocket cargo or utility style pants, black tactical boots (available at WalMart or Big 5), solid black belt and solid belt buckle with no embellishments. Solid black hat optional.

Bravo (Physical Training (P.T.), Tuesday and Thursday): Academy t-shirt, loose-fitting solid black shorts or sweats, black socks and athletic shoes. Shorts are to be within 2" of the knee; black spandex may be worn under the athletic shorts.

Charlie Spirit Wear (Fridays): Athletic shoes, any color socks, black or blue well-fitting jeans without holes, embellishments, or rips, belt and any school shirt or school sweater.

Winter Gear: Solid black beanie, scarves, and gloves. School sweatshirt and/or school jacket.

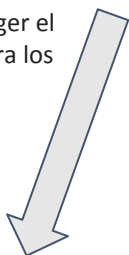
