Dear College Achieve Paterson Faculty, Staff, and Families

College Achieve Public Schools central office was informed today, Monday 3/23, that an employee of College Achieve Paterson Charter School has tested positive for COVID-19. As a result, the staff member was medically advised to self-isolate at home.

The case was self-reported to the school by the staff member; the district is awaiting confirmation by the Paterson City Health Department.

As a precautionary measure, it is recommended that all individuals who were in College Achieve Paterson Charter School building at 21 Market Street prior to closure should self-isolate for two weeks, and continue to follow the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines relating to COVID-19.
