The Honors Academy provides students the opportunity to distinguish themselves in the college admissions process and represents the highest academic course of study at John Carroll Catholic High School.

REQUIREMENTS

Students in the Honors Academy must take the following courses:

10th grade: Introduction to AP Capstone

11th grade: AP Seminar (taught concurrently with AP Lang)

12th grade: AP Research

In addition, students must:

- Complete a total of 12 honors or AP courses
(which includes the AP Capstone-related courses)
- Complete through level III of foreign language
- Maintain a GPA of 3.5
