### Certified Logistics Associate (CLA)

---

This course provides an overview of the world of supply chain logistics and good workplace habits in the context of the industry, including: Global Supply Chain Life Cycle; Logistics Environment; Material Handling Equipment and Safety and Safety Principles. CLA is a prerequisite for CLT.

### Certified Logistics Technician (CLT)

---

This course provides a more detailed, technical look at each of the main activities involved in handling materials throughout the supply chain including: Product Receiving and Storage; Order Processing; Packaging and Shipping; Inventory Control; Transportation Modes and Dispatch and Tracking.
