RE: Notice to the Commissioner of Education of Woodsboro ISD Board of Trustees' Approval of Amendment to Local District of Innovation (DOI) Plan

Dear Commissioner Morath,

In accordance with TAC 102.1313, Amendment, Rescission, or Renewal which specifies:

(a) A district innovation plan may be amended, rescinded, or renewed if the action is approved by a majority vote of the district-level committee established under the Texas Education Code (TEC), 11.251, or a comparable committee if the district is exempt from that section, and a two-thirds majority vote of the Board of Trustees.

(a) Amendment. An amendment to an approved plan does not change the date of the term of designation as an innovation district. Exemptions that were already formally approved are not required to be reviewed.

At the Woodsboro ISD District Education Improvement Committee (DEIC) meeting held on November 19, 2019, the possibility of an amendment was discussed. On January 14, 2020, the written document was presented to the DEIC who voted unanimously to approve of the proposed amendment to the DOI.

The amendment was unanimously approved by the Woodsboro ISD Board of Trustees on January 20, 2020. This information will be posted on the district webpage for at least 30 days with the proposed amendment beginning February 6, 2020.
