Peanut Allergy

A student on our campus has a severe food allergy. Strict avoidance of peanut products is the only way to prevent a life-threatening allergic reaction. We are asking for your assistance in providing the student with a safe learning environment.

If exposed, the student may develop a life-threatening allergic reaction that requires emergency treatment. To reduce the risk of exposure, the classrooms should be peanut safe. Please limit sending any food containing peanuts for your child to eat during lunch. Any exposure through contact or ingestion can cause a severe reaction. Since lunch is eaten in the cafeteria, if your child brings a peanut product for lunch, she/he may be asked to move. This plan will maintain safety allowing all students to enjoy their lunch.

Free & Reduced Lunch Applications

Each year, parents must apply for free and reduced lunches for their children, even if they received free or reduced meals in the past. Please note this process can take up to two weeks at the beginning of the school year as approval is determined by household income. Applications are distributed on the first day of school.

Special Areas Rotation

Students will rotate to special areas on a five-day rotation (A Day-E Day). Should the school be closed for a holiday, inclement weather, etc., the specials day is not missed as it would be with a day of the week rotation. The rotation picks up where it left off on the last attended school day.

Lunches & Microwaves

We are requesting that microwavable meals be limited. Our lunch monitors need to focus on the safety of all students and are not always available to assist a child with the sole student microwave. Microwavable meals also require a lengthy amount of time to heat and we want to ensure that each student has time to eat. Keep in mind that the cafeteria provides hot lunches. Please note that beginning in the 2018-2019 school year, lunch snacks (such as popcorn) will not be microwaved due to time, equipment, and personnel limitations.
