2. Game Lengths

Freshman Boys and Girls 7 minute quarters

JV Boys and Girls 7 minute quarters

Varsity Boys and Girls 8 minute quarters

3. Halftime Lengths

a. Secondary Gym: 5 minute half

 Main Gym: 10 minute half

b. Halftime shooting will involve teams from the game immediately following the current game

c. The players must be wearing game shoes and must be in uniform or in travel warm-ups to be on the floor

d. Teams must shoot at their teams 2nd half basket

e. The clock will be froze at 4 minutes if there is any type of halftime performance, parents night, etc. to allow teams access to floor to shoot

4. Warm Up Times

Sub-Varsity 6 minutes

Varsity 12 minutes

5. Officials

a. Home team will choose number of officials for each game, 3 or 2 man crew.

b. Scratch Policy: Victoria, Rice Belt, Brazosport and Gulf Coast officials will be used by teams in district 24AAA. UIL scratch rule will be followed. Coaches will try to let visiting teams know which officials are scheduled to call game, but they

are aware that sometimes last minute changes are made by chapter secretaries and that is out of coach's hands.

- c. Coaches can officiate for sub-varsity if officials don't show
 - d. Officials that do not show for varsity game. Schools will wait at least one hour. If no officials show then game will be played on next available playing date as per UIL Rules at the same scheduled site with the game time agreed upon by both coaches.
6. Game Ball
- a. The official game ball will be any regulation basketball for the boys and girls, with the girls using a 28.5 ball provided by the home team along with 6 warm up balls will be provided for visiting team.
7. Timers and Scorers
- a. The timer and scorer for all varsity contests **MUST** be an adult or from the immediate basketball staff
 - b. For sub-varsity games, adult timers and scorers are highly recommended, but games will be played as scheduled
 - c. The home team will provide a space for the visiting team's bookkeeper at the scorer's table
8. Home Team will wear white and Visitors will wear dark uniforms
9. Home Team Provides Water and Cups and 6 balls for warm up
10. District Champion will purchase its own trophy
11. Pre-Game Music
- a. Home Team shall control volume and lyrics
 - b. Bands playing at home games will not sit directly behind visiting team bench
 - c. No noisemakers (UIL Rules)
12. District Game Results
- All high school (Varsity) results will be e-mailed to Bryan Blonar at bblonar@bolingisd.net or texted to 979-531-9721 that night or early next morning. He will send the district standings spreadsheet to all superintendents, principals, head coaches and AD's every Wednesday and Monday morning when he receives the scores from all coaches.
13. All District Meeting & Selection
- a. The district meeting for **GIRLS** will be held by the District Champion Wednesday, Feb.6th. Time will be determined by Champion
 - b. The district meeting for **BOYS** will be held by the District Champion Wednesday, Feb.13th. Time will be determined by Champion

- c. MVP, Offensive MVP, Defensive MVP, Newcomer of the Year, Coach Of the Year
- d. Number of players on first and second team
8 on first team and 8 on second team; no more than 10 on either team if there is a tie

JUNIOR HIGH BASKETBALL

1. The Junior High will follow the same double round robin format as the high school with 10 games played.
2. Day of week
 - a. Thursday unless mutually agreed upon by both schools or school holidays; if one school is hosting a tourney (HS or JH) those JH games scheduled for Thursday will be attempted to be moved to Monday of the same week
3. Game Site and Start Time
 - a. Boys and Girls will play at opposite sites
 - b. Start time will be at 5:00 Order of games will be 7B,8B,7A,8A
4. Game Length
 - a. For A Teams 6 minute quarters (8th grade may play 7 minute quarters if agreed upon by both coaches).
 - b. For B Teams there will be two 15 minute halves played. The clock will only stop the last minute of the game if the score of the game is within 10 points.
 - c. For A games clock will only be ran if mutually agreed on by both coaches.
 - d. In case of tie A-Games will have one 3 minute overtime period.
5. Warm-Up Length: 6 minutes
6. Halftime Length: 5 minutes
7. Home Team Provides Water and Cups and 6 balls for warm up
8. Timers and Scorekeepers Adults/School Coaches recommended
9. Officials TASO officials recommended, but coaches may officiate
