COMMUNITY

Citrus County is a rural, small-town community located on the west central coast of Florida, 75 miles north of Tampa. SRCS provides education for several small communities and isolated residential areas representing a population with diverse cultural backgrounds.

SCHOOL

Seven Rivers Christian School was founded in 1988 as a ministry of Seven Rivers Presbyterian Church to serve the local population of Citrus County. SRCS is a PreK-12 coeducational, college-prep school committed to excellence in a full liberal arts program. The enrollment for 2018-2019 is 480 students, with 97 students in the high school and 21 students in the senior class.

ADMISSION

Admission to Seven Rivers is selective, and decisions are based on a student's potential to perform satisfactory college-preparatory work. Seven Rivers admits students from all ethnic, racial, cultural, and religious backgrounds. Previous school records, standardized test scores, in-house testing, recommendations, and a personal interview are used for admission purposes.

GRADING SYSTEM

The high school utilizes an AB block schedule. Each semester concludes with a comprehensive exam constituting 20% of the semester grade. AP and Dual Enrollment classes are weighted an additional one point in calculating a student's GPA, and Honors classes are weighted an additional one-half point. Earned grades are reported on the transcript, but the reported GPA is weighted. Courses earn one-half of a Carnegie unit of credit each semester.

Individual class grades are calculated on a 100-point scale, but grade point averages are calculated on a traditional 4.0 scale, computed at the end of each semester. Other than recognizing the top three honor graduates, Seven Rivers does not report the rank of individual students. Because classes are small, ranking does not provide a fair measure of student performance or ability.
