Insurance Coverage

We strongly encourage the purchase of insurance for your Chromebook.

Insurance enrollment deadline is August 20th.

For Chromebooks purchased this summer, HP will cover any manufacturer defect or mechanical failure for the first year, but will not cover accidental damage or theft. Please visit the [Insurance](#) section of our website to read about the Worth Ave Group policies, which are available in 1-year and 2-year terms. <https://gpo.worthavegroup.com/gpo/lgusd2>

1 year: \$27.

2 years: \$75. (The 2-year policy will cover all accidents, theft, PLUS manufacturer defect & mechanical failure in the 2nd year.)

For older Chromebooks purchased for the DLI program, you may purchase a 1-year policy through Worth Ave Group that will cover all accidents, theft, PLUS manufacturer defect & mechanical failure.

1 year: \$36.

Note: You will need to select the model of your Chromebook when purchasing insurance. Model numbers are printed on the bottom of each Chromebook.

*Chromebooks purchased in 2016-17 are mostly model **J2L41UT***

*Chromebooks purchased in 2017-18 are model **T4M32UT***

Repair / Tech Support & Temporary Loaners

Please visit the Fisher Office / **Chrome Depot** to report damage/breakage/loss of Chromebook. Parents must sign the *Loaner Agreement form*, and a temporary loaner will be provided to your student while Chromebook is being repaired.

NEW THIS YEAR: Our District Technology Services Department will manage all repairs for the **following** instances:

- Year 1 Chromebooks (purchased 2018-19):
- Manufacturer defect or mechanical failures covered by HP warranty.
- Accidental damage, breakage or theft if parent has a current Worth Ave Group policy.
- Year 2 & 3 Chromebooks:
- Accidental damage, breakage or theft, PLUS mechanical failure or manufacturer defect if parent has a current Worth Ave Group policy.

Please turn your Chromebook in to **Chrome Depot**, fill out loaner agreement, & a temporary loaner will be assigned to your student.

If your computer is not covered by HP's manufacturer warranty (1st year), or a current Worth Ave Group insurance policy, you will be responsible for making repairs to your Chromebook. A list of local repair shops will be provided upon request.
