

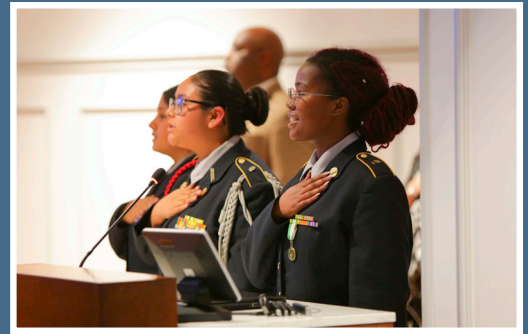


BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 16TH, 2019

BOARD MEETING UPDATE ON CALIFORNIA DASHBOARD



Silvia San Martin, Director of Elementary Education, Curriculum and Instruction, provided a thorough synopsis of California's Accountability and Continuous Improvement System. The state has adopted a metric for mapping and reporting student improvement using the 'Dashboard' to identify strengths and challenges. The Dashboard includes vital data related to chronic absenteeism, suspensions, test scores, graduation rates and college/career readiness. PUSD was afforded the opportunity to participate alongside personnel from various county offices of education to learn about Improvement Science and how COEs are reorganizing their departments to better support school districts. San Martin concluded by highlighting the proactive and newly aligned approaches PUSD will employ to better serve its various student groups with this cutting-edge data.



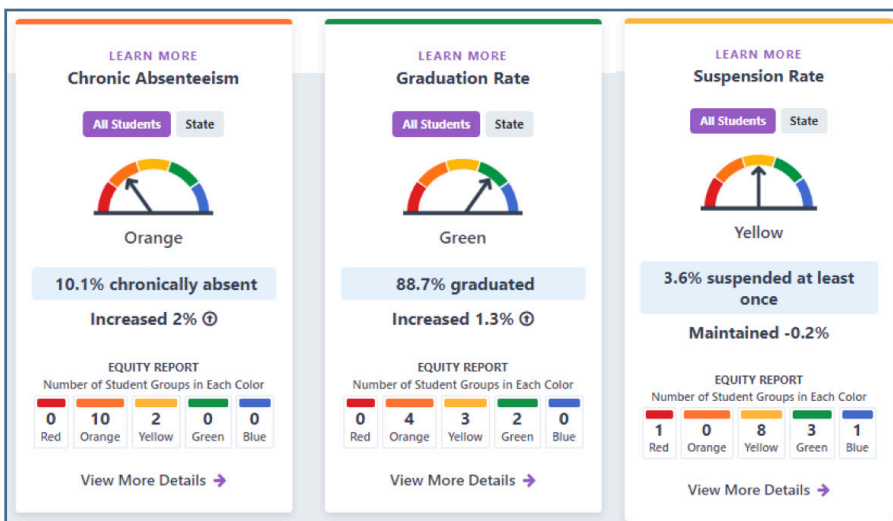
PLEASE STAND
