# FREMONT PRIMARY SCHOOL

## SAFE SCHOOL PLAN NARRATIVE

The goal of Fremont Primary School is to provide a safe, learning environment in which all students have access to a rigorous, grade-level curriculum and support for student growth and success.

Fremont Primary is a transitional kindergarten-fourth grade school. The average enrollment is 359 students. Approximately 72% of working residents of the district are employed in lower wage retail trades or agricultural related jobs. The poverty rate for residents of Calipatria between the ages of 0-24 is 70.4%. The poverty rate for the same age groups across the state is 12.5%. Over 47% of the students are Migrant and 42% are English Learners. In 2012-2013 100% of the students received free and reduced meals. Fremont Primary School is a targeted Title I school. 2018-2019 in a Base year for our Free and reduced lunch program.

The three core beliefs that form the underpinnings of providing a safe school are:

1. Everyone deserves to be respected, no matter their ethnic background, their age, their gender, or their abilities.
2. Students, staff, parents, community members have a stake in the school's success and a role to play in keeping it safe.
3. The school plays many roles and functions; it is a place to learn, a multi-service center that provides student and community services well beyond the traditional school day and beyond the scope of academic learning, a place where staff takes pride in their work and knows that they make a difference.

Fremont Primary's vision is to ensure that every effort and precaution is made to:

1. Provide every child with a safe, orderly and secure environment conducive to learning.
2. Ensure that all students, staff and community members feel safe at school.
3. Collaborate and work effectively with parents, students, staff and community agencies.

# ACTION PLAN FOR COMPONENT 1

## “PEOPLE AND PROGRAMS”

**GOAL:** Fremont Primary School will work collaboratively with parents, pupils, teachers, administrators and community agencies to provide a safe and orderly school and neighborhood.

1. Areas of Pride and Desired Improvements

a. Pride

- Fremont Primary School promotes student involvement and achievement.
- Fremont Primary School has committed to a district wide comprehensive school wide discipline and safety plan.
- Fremont Primary School has developed a collaborative working relationship with Bill E. Young Middle School to ensure a safe and orderly school during a major emergency.

b. Areas of Desired Improvement

- Strengthen the implementation of the comprehensive school wide safety plan through staff training and parental involvement.
- Strengthen the implementation of the comprehensive school wide safety plan through communication with parents and the community. Educate and inform parents of the procedures in the case of an emergency.

**OBJECTIVE 1.1 Fremont Primary School will strengthen the implementation of the comprehensive school wide safety plan in order to promote collaboration and information between parents, pupils, teachers, and administrators to provide a safe and orderly school.**

1. Related Strategies and Activities
  - a. Fremont Primary School will provide support and training for staff on the comprehensive school wide safety plan.
  - b. Fremont Primary School will provide support activities to ensure parents have the opportunity to become aware of the school wide safety plan by providing a school handbook to all staff and parents regarding the safety plan.
  - c. Conduct fire and disaster drills as prescribed by law with an emphasis on locking down and reunification of students with parents.
2. Resources Required
  - a. Staff training and materials (copy of the plan and handbook)
  - b. Parent (copy of the handbook); yearly parent meeting to explain the handbook.
3. Personnel Assignments
  - a. District staff
  - b. Site Principal
4. Timeframe
  - a. Staff training ongoing
  - b. Parent meeting at Back to School night in September
  - c. Semiannual summary reminder sent home of parental procedures in the case of an emergency.

## **ACTION PLAN FOR COMPONENT 2**

### **“Physical Environment”**

**GOAL: Provide a safe, orderly, and secure environment conducive to learning.**

1. Areas of Pride and Desired Improvements

a. Pride

- Fremont Primary School provides staff and students with modern facilities; new classrooms, library and restrooms.
- Campus has designed areas for student and visitor enter and exit zones
- Campus has well defined student drop-off zone
- Bus loading/unloading zone away from parent /visitor vehicles
- Phone system allows communication between office and classrooms
- Alarm system in place for fire drills, and emergencies

b. Area of Desired Improvement

- Improve student security.
- Improve communication during an emergency between all classrooms on campus.

**OBJECTIVE 2.1 Fremont Primary School will improve the student security and communication between all classrooms on campus.**

1. Related Strategies and Activities

- a. All teachers and staff will have the ability to lock the classroom they are in during the instructional day.
- b. Notify and enforce all visitors to register at the office prior to entering classrooms.
- c. Research way to funnel visitors into office and keep gates closed (not locked) during school day.
- d. Purchase additional two way radios to improve communication in case of an emergency.

2. Resources Required

- a. Purchase additional two way radios and batteries
- b. Personnel Assignments
  - Administrator
- c. Time frame for completion
  - October 2019

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
