A note from the Nurse's Office

We're finally getting around to finishing up the yearly screenings for our kiddos. Ohio law mandates that children in grades Kindergarten, 1st, 3rd, and 5th receive a vision/hearing assessment. Any other child can/will be screened by parent and/or teacher request. Any child who fails this screening will receive a referral letter from the nurse indicating the need for follow up.

Cough/cold season is still not over. Please dress children appropriately for the fluctuating weather and encouraged them to wash hands regularly, and have good cough/sneeze etiquette (in the inside of the elbow) to help prevent the spread of germs. Thus far this year, we've seen a variety of different illness including strep, croup, and influenza, to name a few. Please continue to be vigilant in the prevention of spreading bacteria/viruses.

Growth and Development lessons for the 4th/5th grade boys and girls are soon approaching. Letters will go home with students this month regarding content and specific date/time for this, though will likely be in May – after state testing.

Quick reminder for all parents to remember to pick up your child's medication at the conclusion of this school year, as well as picking up a new medication form for the physician to fill out for next school year's medication needs. Another reminder will be added in next month's newsletter.

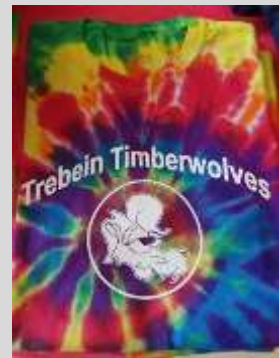
We need to know how many adults will be eating with us that day so our wonderful lunchroom staff can prepare. Please come in uniform or wear purple if you have it!
