Filing Petitions for Seats on the Board of Education

Nominating Form (available at the District Clerk's Office or the district website at www.bcsdk12.org)

Information Regarding Petition

Eligibility to run for Member of the Board of Education

- Must be able to read and write;
- Must be a qualified voter of the district; that is, a citizen of the United States, at least 18 years of age or older and not adjudged to be an incompetent;
(Note: a convicted felon is barred from running for a seat on a board of education if his or her maximum prison sentence has not expired or if he or she has not been pardoned or discharged from parole.)
- Must be and have been a resident (but need not be a taxpayer) of the district for a continuous and uninterrupted period of at least one year;
- May not have been removed from any school district office within the preceding year;
- May not reside with another member of the same school board as a member of the same family;
- May not be a current employee of the school board; and
- May not simultaneously hold another incompatible public office.

Number of Signatures Required

Nominating petitions must be signed by at least 25 qualified district voters or 2 percent of the number of voters who voted in the previous annual election of the members of the Board of Education, whichever is greater.

Previous Elections May 15, 2018 586 Voters

Therefore at least 25 signatures are required for the Nominating Petition, which must be filed with the District Clerk by **5:00 pm on April 22, 2019.**

Qualified Voter May Sign Nominating Petition

A qualified voter is:

- A citizen of the United States
- 18 Years Old
- Resident of the school district for at least 30 days immediately prior to the election at which he or she seeks to vote.

Number of Nominating Petitions You May Sign

There is no limit on the number of nominating petitions a district resident may sign.
