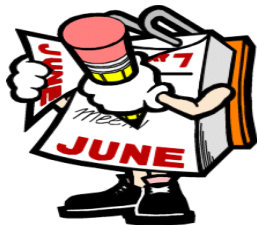

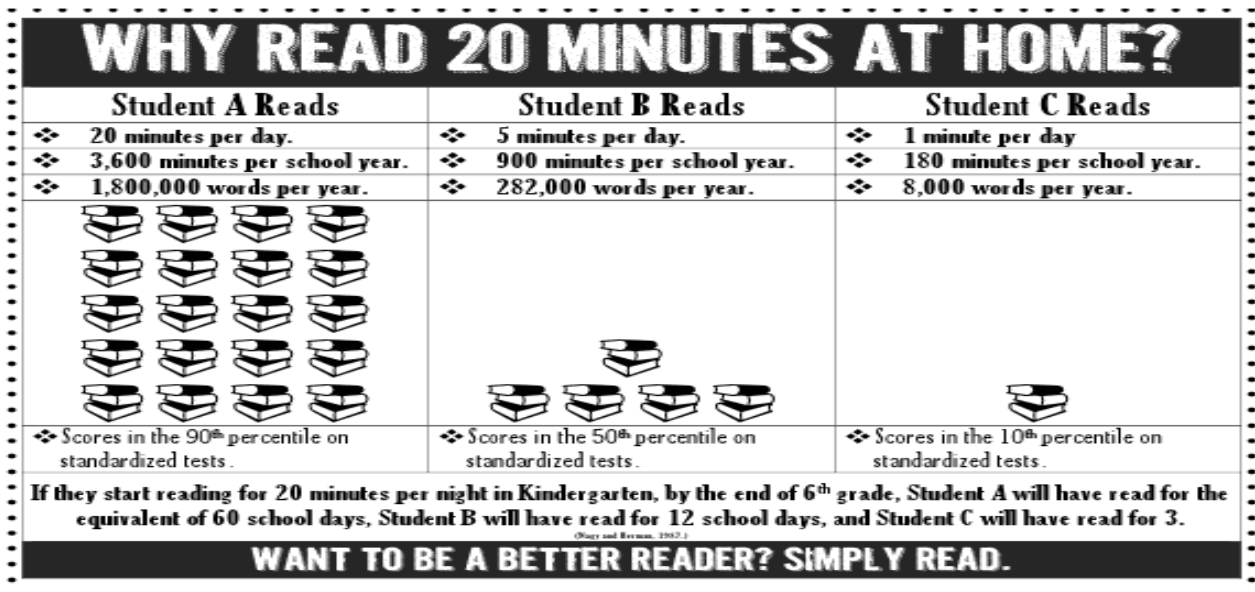


Teacher's Corner

Our school year is off to a GREAT start! Our new Third Graders did not disappoint. They received the most votes from the teachers and won the first Heart Beat Spirit Banner! I'm sure Fourth and Fifth Graders will be working hard to earn next week.

In Third Grade ELAR we have been setting up and organizing our Reader's Notebooks. We read a book called Picture Day Perfection (it had a surprise ending). We are learning how to write summaries using the Somebody, Wanted, But, So, Then method. We are digging into new vocabulary and reviewing Nouns and Verbs.

This week we get to visit the Library! Each student will get to select and bring home 2 books. It is very important that they select books they actually want to read because this will be their homework! After getting their books, each student will be expected to read a minimum of 20 minutes each night. We will gradually increase that number as they build their stamina. I can't emphasize enough how important "just reading" is. As your child finishes reading, ask them who the story was about, and what happened to the character. These simple questions are the stepping stone to great comprehension.
