Travel Reporting:

All Westwood ISD employees, students, and families should take extra precautions when traveling and follow travel guidelines provided by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

All Westwood ISD employees, students, and families:

- who have or are planning to travel in the next month to a Level 2 or Level 3 zone; or
- have had close contact with someone with COVID-19 during travel

must register their travel plans by using the [Westwood ISD Travel Reporting Form](#), upon return from spring break.

Please be aware if you or someone in your household has traveled to a Level 2 or Level 3 zone you will be subject to a minimum 14-day quarantine. The 14-day quarantine requirement may be added to other areas should they become classified as Level 2 or Level 3 zones.
