Parents may walk their child onto the playground on the **first day of school**. Your child will be able to locate their classroom cone with their teacher name on it, drop off their backpack and play on the playground until the bell rings. Please say your goodbyes when the bell rings as we are excited to get the school day going. After school, if walking to pick up your child, please designate a place to meet outside of the playground gate.

We are a large school with hundreds of people coming and going each day. For the safety of all, we ask that you please....

Before School - Plan your child's day within times that our grounds/crosswalks are supervised. Crosswalk supervision does not begin until 8:35 a.m. (9:35 a.m. Thursdays). **Playground supervision begins at 8:40.**

Valet - Remain in your vehicle at all times if you are accessing our student drop off valet lanes with your child/children. Our awesome supervisors will assist your children. Please have your child sit on the passenger side of the vehicle with their belongings ready to go. **DO NOT** let your child out before a supervisor is there to assist due to the two lanes of traffic. Patience is always appreciated.

Golf Carts - Golf carts will be treated like vehicles and must use the valet. **NO** golf carts on school sidewalks.

Please do not use the visitor parking for loading/unloading your children.

Attendance - Remember to notify the office at 558-4312 if your child will be late or absent. If your child will be arriving late and would like hot lunch, we must have that information by 9:00 a.m. Please remember to check your child into the office upon arrival if they are tardy or arriving at a later time.

Visitors/Volunteering - All visitors **MUST** check in at the office. Anytime you are volunteering or visiting Liberty Lake Elementary, you must wear a badge or name tag during school hours. We love volunteers! If you are interested in helping out in the classroom or attending classroom parties you must become a registered volunteer

Pets - We are a large campus and must provide a safe and healthy environment for children with allergies. If you can keep pets at home it would be greatly appreciated. If you choose to walk your dog to the school, it must be leashed at all times and kept away from the gates where students enter and exit. You may wait with your dog at the sidewalk, away from students.

Cell Phones/Electronic Devices - Please remind your children that while on school property all cell phones, apple watches, and other electronic devices are to be turned off and remain in backpacks. This includes the time your children are waiting for their transportation.

Blackboard - Parent Alert System - CVSD utilizes Blackboard Connect to keep parents up to date on events, activities, bus changes, principal newsletters, and also in case of an emergency. Blackboard sends messages through email, phone and text. The system also notifies parents about student attendance. If your child is absent from school and has not been excused you will receive an attendance call automatically. Our attendance line is available to leave messages 24 hours a day at 509-558-4312.

Cross Country - Attached is a complete packet about our free cross country program that is offered for student's grade 1-5. **Please save** the packet if you decide to join us so you can refer to the calendar and information to answer your questions throughout the season. It includes information about what to expect at the meets, our calendar, etc.
