**TUITION ASSISTANCE AND SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION**

*Bishop Foley Catholic High School's scholarship and grant program supports our commitment to enroll the most talented and diverse students in the area. These discounts and financial aid grants are an outward sign of our commitment to our families that are seeking a quality faith-based education. We award need-based financial aid and tuition assistance each year. Need-based financial aid awards are grant awards that do not need to be repaid.*

**SUGGESTIONS**

- Students are encouraged to apply for all tuition grants and/or scholarships for which they feel they may qualify.
- When determining financial need, Bishop Foley Catholic considers the number of children in Catholic school, college, special family situations, etc. If your financial situation changes significantly throughout the year, please contact in writing the Principal explaining your circumstances. Sometimes additional grant money becomes available after the school year begins.

**OTHER FORMS OF TUITION ASSISTANCE**

- *Parish subsidies/grants/awards*
  - Many of the parishes in the Archdiocese of Detroit have programs to assist students who attend Catholic schools. It is always advisable to check with your parish for requirements.
- *Scrip*
  - Scrip is a program that enables you to earn money for tuition by pre-purchasing gift certificates to any of the over 200 stores, restaurants, movie theaters or gas stations in the area that participate. A list of companies that participate is listed on the forms available in the Main Office. Each of the contributing companies offers a rebate – a particular percent of the amount purchased to be returned to Bishop Foley Catholic to apply toward your student's tuition. Extended families and neighbors can also place orders in your student's name. Some families receive between \$300 and \$500, and others receive over \$2,000 per year.
- *Bishop Foley Catholic Tuition discounts*
  - Multiple Child Discount. To qualify for the Multiple Child Discount, all of the children must be attending Bishop Foley Catholic concurrently. The discount is applied to the oldest child's account. For the 2<sup>nd</sup> child, the discount applied is \$1,000. For the 3<sup>rd</sup> + child, the discount applied is \$2,000.
  - Alumni Discount. This discount is applied to one child's account. The discount applied is \$500.

## **BISHOP FOLEY CATHOLIC TUITION GRANTS**

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Who Qualifies:	Accepted Bishop Foley Catholic students, grades 9 through 12. Grants are allocated based on financial need and family circumstances.
Application Deadline:	Primary allocation for applications received by February 22, 2019. Secondary allocation for applications received after February 22, 2019.
Application Process:	Complete the FACTS Financial Aid form. Mail the FACTS form (or submit the online FACTS form) directly to the FACTS office.  <i>Note: The FACTS form will be available in January in the Main Office or online at <a href="http://www.bishopfoley.org">www.bishopfoley.org</a>.</i>
Maximum Amount:	Decisions are based upon a family's income level, family size, number of students in Catholic schools, monthly expenses and special circumstances or hardships. The total amount of tuition assistance provided each year is based upon the availability of funds and the number of applicants.
Award Announcement:	March 1, 2019 for Primary Allocation, continuous awards granted after March 1st for Secondary Allocation.

## **ARCHDIOCESE OF DETROIT (AOD) TUITION GRANT**

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Who Qualifies:	Accepted Bishop Foley Catholic students, grades 9 through 12. Grants are allocated based on financial need.
Application Deadline:	AOD deadline for application is April 1 <sup>st</sup> .
Application Process:	Complete the FACTS Financial Aid form. Mail the FACTS form (or submit the online FACTS form) directly to the FACTS office.  <i>Note: Only <u>one</u> FACTS Financial Aid form is needed for application for both the Bishop Foley tuition grants and the AOD tuition grants. All applicants must be a registered parishioner of an AOD parish and request a signature from the pastor on the FACTS form.</i>
Maximum Amount:	2018-19 amounts are \$800/\$950/\$1,100 depending on need assessment. 2019-20 amount is TBD by the AOD.
Award Announcement:	Summer 2019

### **JANINE KAIRIS – FAITH & GRATITUDE SCHOLARSHIP**

Who Qualifies:	Incoming BFC students in grades 9-12, in good academic standing.
Application Deadline:	March 22, 2019
Application Process:	Students must be formally accepted at Bishop Foley Catholic and write an essay of 250 words or more describing the importance of dedication to your studies and how your faith has impacted that dedication. The essay, Biographical Information form, and Application Checklist, must be submitted to the Main Office by the application deadline.
Maximum Amount:	\$500 (non-renewable)
Award Announcement:	April 1, 2019

### **"KEEP YOUR EYES FIXED ON JESUS" SCHOLARSHIP - IN HONOR OF ARCHBISHOP VIGNERON**

Who Qualifies:	BFC students in grades 10-12, with a 3.2 GPA or higher
Application Deadline:	March 22, 2019
Application Process:	Students must write an essay of 250 words or more describing their involvement with the new evangelization at their Church, school, or in their community and how these works have strengthened their faith and "Kept Their Eyes Fixed On Jesus." The essay must be submitted along with the Biographical Information form and the Application Checklist by the application deadline. Final selection may require an interview with BFC administrator(s).
Maximum Amount:	\$500 (non-renewable)
Award Announcement:	April 1, 2019

### **"MAKE YOUR IMPRESSION ON THE WORLD" SCHOLARSHIP**

Who Qualifies:	BFC students in grades 10-12, with a 3.2 GPA or higher
Application Deadline:	March 22, 2019
Application Process:	In honor of Mr. Valinski, a long time history teacher at Bishop Foley Catholic, write an essay of 250 words or more describing how you plan to

use your BFC education to impact the world. Essay must be submitted along with the Biographical Information form and Application Checklist to the Main Office by the application deadline.

Maximum Amount: \$500 (non-renewable)
