## Kindergarten Registration

March 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, & 12<sup>th</sup>

8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

You DO NOT have to bring your child with you to register for Kindergarten. All Kindergarten students will be assigned a day within the first 5 days of school to return for screening. After screening days, ALL Kindergarten students will resume regular full day schedules.

### What to Bring:

- Birth Certificate
- Social Security Card
- Shot Record
- Current Health Physical
- 3 Proofs of Permanent Residency



\*\*The following are forms of documentation that will be accepted as proofs of residency. A total of three (3) proofs of residency are **REQUIRED.**\*\*

At LEAST one (1) of the following MUST be provided:

1. Deed or Property Tax Statement
2. Mortgage Statement
3. Rental Agreement/Lease
4. Shared Residence Affidavit or Landlord/Tenant Agreement

**AND** At least two (2) of the following MUST be provided:

1. Utility Bill
2. Phone Bill
3. Cable Bill
4. Bank Statement
5. Insurance Statement
6. Current Government Issued Document that contains same address (public assistance documents such as food stamps, W-2 Form, Drivers License, Passport, Voter Registration Card)

As enacted, with certain exceptions, requires that children entering Kindergarten be five years of age on or before August 31 for the 2013-2014 school year and on or before August 15 for all school years thereafter; if the Director of Schools finds through evaluation and testing, at the request of the parent or guardian, that a child who is five years of age on or before September 30 is sufficiently mature emotionally and academically, then the child may be permitted to Kindergarten. -Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 6
