Students plan for next school year

With school now in the fourth quarter, St. Joseph Catholic School students already are planning for the 2019-2020 school year.

On Friday, students in Grades 7 through 12 submitted their course selections for the next school year. School officials will use those lists to begin planning, preparing and scheduling classes for next year.

One of the most important decisions high school students will make, especially those who are rising ninth graders, is which foreign language they will

take. Students must successfully complete at least two years of a foreign language in order to graduate; they could take more than two years.

St. Joe offers Spanish, French and Latin. On Friday, March 8, eighth graders attended the Foreign Language Fair in the St. Joe cafeteria. They met with students currently enrolled in foreign language classes as well as faculty who plan to teach the classes next year.
