Spring Semester 19: I & E Period Course Offerings – Pick your top 3 choices

American Sign Language *Ms. Mejia*

Students cannot retake class. ASL is a visually perceived, gesture based language. Learn to communicate through the use of ASL, learn basic signing skills, and learn about deaf culture!

Art of Rap *Mr. Chun*

Learn to write your own rap lyrics and if you have the spirit, let the people hear it. Serious & committed students needed.

Brain Games *Mr.Santana*

An interactive class that will challenge students to exercise their brain by solving puzzles, riddles and playing games that stimulate mental activity.

Basketball Final Four *Mr.Fenwick*

This class is for students that want to play basketball, improve their offensive and defensive skills in competitive game play. There will be two skill levels to choose from: division 1 and division 2.

Cartooning *Mr. Jenkins*
