Pick up and read your reserved copy, then join us for a lively discussion.

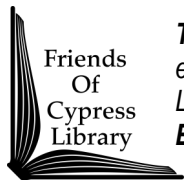
ESL Conversation Club—Adults/teens of all ESL levels—Enjoy listening to, playing with, and using English.
