

CHMS Student Placement/Course Offerings

Student Schedules

Student schedules are based upon specific student and school needs. This includes, but is not limited to any student with an IEP, behavior intervention plan (BIP), academic intervention (RTI), or a Section 504 plan.

The administration reserves the right to change student schedules at any time based upon the needs of the school, including academic performance and behavioral concerns.

Data Driven Scheduling

Students who are projected below TNReady proficiency, who fail benchmark tests, or based upon universal screener results will receive immediate academic support through Response to Intervention (RTI). This may include losing the privilege of attending Exploratory Classes.

Students will receive the following course offerings in all grade levels:

1 96-minute block of ELA	1 Period of Science
1 96-minute block of Math	1 Period Exploratory/Intervention
1 Period of Social Studies	1 Period of Lunch/RTI/Recess

Honors Course Offerings and Placement Criteria:

7th Grade Accelerated Math:

Students who score at or above the 90th percentile on the previous year's TNReady Assessment will be eligible for placement in accelerated math.

7th Grade Honors Math

Students who score at or above the 80th percentile on the previous year's TNReady Assessment will be eligible for placement in honors math.

8th Grade Integrated Math

Students who have a combined Iowa Assessment and TNReady percentile rank at or above 185 will be eligible for placement in honors math.

8th Grade Honors Math

Students who do not meet the requirements for Integrated Math, but place at or above the 80th percentile will be eligible for placement in honors math.

8th Grade Pre-AP ELA

Students who score at the mastery level of their TNReady ELA assessment in 7th grade will be eligible for placement in the Pre-AP course in 8th grade.

All honors placements are at the discretion of CHMS administration

Exploratory Classes

Exploratory classes are a privilege at Christiana Middle School. Selections are based upon, but not limited to class size, students with IEPs, previous exploratory classes etc. Students meeting or exceeding academic/behavioral goals will be enrolled in one of the following exploratory courses each nine week:
