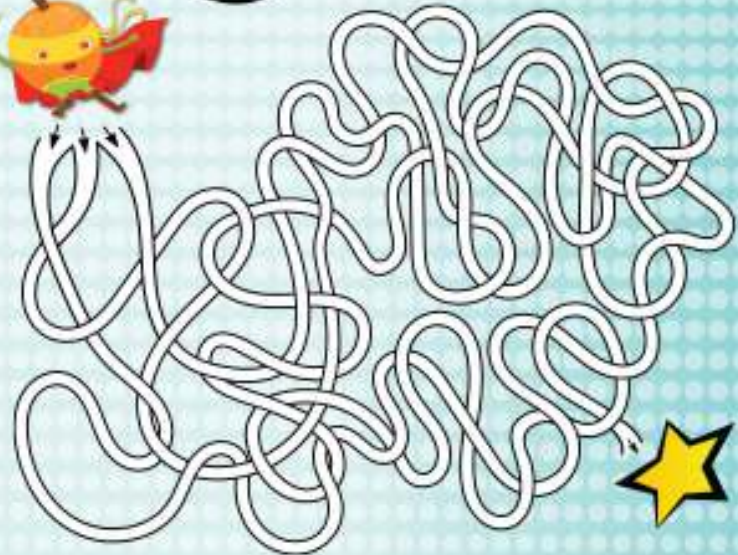
FUN FACTS
