The main goal of the Engineering Summer Camp is to develop, grow, and maintain the engineering bridge program targeting Texas high school students entering civil, computer, biomedical, electrical, and mechanical engineering. **Overnight** campers will be fully immersed in the campus life experience by spending the week living on campus in one of the residence halls. Evening/night supervision, meals, and activities will be provided.

Day Camp is \$300 and Overnight Camp is \$550. Payment is due in full to complete registration.
