

## K-8 Loudon County Summer Scholars Guide 2019-2020

Rising Grade: 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade

School: Greenback School

Curriculum covered during the previous year that requires continued retention and repetition for students:

- Add and subtract one and two-digit numbers fluently
- Write complete sentences with capital letters and correct punctuation
- Read fluently with expression, natural pauses, and with a goal of reading 120 words per minute by the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> grade
- Spell grade level appropriate words correctly (know all letters and sounds, how to spell CVC words, words with consonants blends and/or digraphs wh, sh, ch, th, ck, words with suffix -s, -es, -ed)

Curriculum for the upcoming school year of which students should be aware, and areas that might be a challenge for students, with suggestions on how students can prepare for the upcoming year:

- Identify the main topic of a multi-paragraph text
- Understand author's purpose
- Identify and explain how text and graphic features contribute and clarify a text
- Ask and answer questions from various types of texts
- Spell one, two, and even three syllable words using a specific phonics rule or skill
- Understand place value up to 1,000
- Add and subtract up to 1,000 using regrouping strategies
- Solve addition and subtraction word problems
- Solve basic multiplication facts using a variety of strategies
- Tell time to the 5 minutes on an analog clock and use time words
- Identify coins and count money values greater than \$1.00

Suggested Activities/Practice Assignments

- Read at least 20 minutes a day
- Keep a writing journal to record summer activities, write stories, and record important events

- Begin to read analog clocks and count different money values (coins) up to \$1.00
