



Ledesma Elementary Halloween Costume Guidelines

Students may wear Halloween costumes to school on *Thursday, October 31, 2019*. There will be a costume parade at 9:15 AM for all students and parents. All costumes must adhere to the following conditions:

- Students must come to school dressed in their costume.
- Oak Grove District dress code enforced – no bare midriffs or “revealing” clothing, appropriate shoes must be worn, etc.
- You must be able to sit, walk, breathe, see and hear! (please make sure that students can see well through their masks)
- Costumes cannot promote use of violence or weapons of any kind. No fake blood, make up or gore.
- No pretend “prop” weapons such as water pistols, knives or swords.
- All school rules will be enforced (i.e., no skateboards, no knives, no props that are usually not allowed at school, etc.)
- Costumes may not be offensive or inappropriate in any way
- The final decision on all costumes will be made by the administration and teachers.
- All costumes will be taken off after the parade and or before lunch begins. Please make sure that your child has a change of clothes on underneath their costume so that it may be removed easily after the parade. Please send a bag with your child for costume storage.
- All family members are welcome to join us for the parade. Please *stand* in the following area for viewing: along the green fence that surrounds the blacktop. **Parents are not allowed to stand or view from the class hallways.**
- Please see **individual teacher information regarding classroom celebrations.**

Thursday, October 31st will be an early release day. All students will be dismissed at 2:05 PM
