

SHS Kids Club: “At A Glance”

Spend the summer playing games, creating art, making friends, going on field trips, swimming, bowling and more. SHS Kids Club is the perfect cure to summer boredom. This group is always on the move doing fun activities. Participants will have the opportunity to choose which activity they would like to participate in daily.

Dates and Times

SHS Kids Club is offered Monday through Friday from June 17 through August 2, with no program on Thursday, July 4. You may only bring your child to Kids Club on the days you have registered for. Kids Club Drop off is at 1:00 pm at SHS Youth Center. Structured activities are scheduled until 4:00 pm. You may pick your child up anytime between 4:00 - 5:30 pm on the SHS Front Lawn or if there is inclement weather, in the SHS Youth Center. Be sure to drop your child off on time as different activities are scheduled each day which may include walking to Estabrook Park, Lake Bluff Elementary School or Atwater Beach.

Sign in & Sign Out

Participants should meet at the SHS Youth Center in the Physical Education Building at Shorewood High School. Participants are responsible for signing their name on the check-in sheet. Parents will sign their children out by indicating the time they left. If your child has permission to sign themselves out, this must be indicated on the Child Information Form as well as if anyone other than a parent/guardian is picking up your child. If weather permits, pick up will be on the SHS Front Lawn.

Weekly Calendars

A weekly calendar of activities will be available on the Shorewood District website at www.shorewoodschoools.org (under the Recreation and Community Services Tab). The weekly calendar will include games, activities and themes for the upcoming week. At SHS Kids Club, participants are able to choose between activity options each day. Please check this calendar each week to see what those options are and to ensure that your child has the appropriate attire for each day's activity.

Fun Fridays

Every Friday, a special event will take place at SHS Kids Club. The special events might be combined in a large group activity with Atwater and Junior Kids Clubs. Some Fun Fridays will take place at a different location in Shorewood, but pick up and drop off will always be at **Shorewood High School**.

What to Bring

Attire: Please make sure your child dresses comfortably and wears shoes that they can run and play in. Athletic shoes are preferred. Be sure to send along a swimsuit, towel, waterproof bag, and clothes to change into when they have a water activity. Check weekly calendar for scheduled activities.

Extras: Please note that your child will be outside whenever the weather permits. Sunscreen and bug spray should be applied at home in addition to including a supply in children's bags to reapply throughout the day.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I sign my child up for Kids Club on the day of?

All registrations must be completed by 12 noon the business day prior to the day of supervision. If there is room in the program, you can call our office directly to sign up for Kids Club after this time with a \$10 late fee added onto the course fee.

If I have a concern regarding SHS Kids Club, who should I contact?

If my child is absent, do I need to notify the Recreation Department?

It is not necessary to notify the Recreation Department if your child will be absent from Kids Club. We will see that your child is absent when they have not been signed in on the roster for the day. Please note that no refunds, class transfers, or credits for SHS Kids Club will be granted after June 13, 2019.

My child is signed up for afternoon classes. Will you escort my child to and from these programs?

We are **UNABLE** to escort your child to and from afternoon programs due to the staffing needs that this service would require. All transportation arrangements for afternoon classes must be made on the parent/guardian's part.

What do I do if I am running late to pick my child up at the end of the program?

We ask that you be observant of your pick up time and arrive before the program closes for the day. All children must be signed out on the daily sign-out sheet. Any parent that picks up their child after 5:30 pm will be assessed a fee of \$5.00 for every 5 minutes they are late. These fees will be paid to the Shorewood Recreation Department within one week of the late pickup. Monies will not be accepted by program leaders. Late payments can be made over the phone or in person at the Recreation Department.

We understand emergencies may occur, so if you find yourself in such a predicament, please call the Recreation Office. This courtesy will alleviate anxiety on the part of the staff and your child.

What forms do I need to fill out?

Each child participating in Kids Club must have a Child Information Form completed and turned in prior to their first day at the program. If your child is signed up for Home Base and you have already turned an info sheet in, you do not need to submit an additional one to Kids Club.

What happens when there is inclement weather (including extreme heat)?

In the event of inclement weather, the program will still be held and will still meet at the SHS Youth Center. We will modify the program as best we can to accommodate inclement weather days. We will have access to the North Gym if we need to relocate the program indoors.
