Purpose

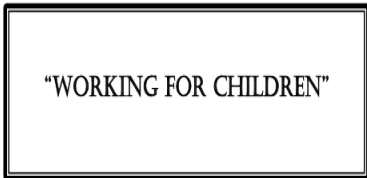
The Hampton District one Education Foundation exists to be able to provide for and meet the needs of prek-12th grade students who are enrolled in Hampton School District One.
