Notes on Ephesians:

In this letter, Paul expands on some of the important points of the Christian faith. God's grace in Jesus Christ is the one and only reason we have been brought into the gathering of believers called the church. Ephesus was an important city of the Roman Empire. Paul had spent quite awhile there and had met with some great success and great opposition. (see Acts 19) Apparently, this letter was written while Paul was in prison in Rome. (60 AD) Paul also gives some very practical advise on how to best live out our earthly lives in harmonious relationships as we remember our relationship to Christ,. This fine letter will help all as they live their lives for their Lord.

Questions on Ephesians:

1. Chapter 1 - What strength does it give to you to know you have been chosen by God as described in this chapter?
2. Chapter 1- Look specifically at the part Christ has in our redemption. Write down 2 or 3 points.
3. Chapter 2: 1-7 – What were our chances for eternal life when we were “dead in our transgressions?”
4. Chapter 2:8-10 – These very clear and important verses help us to understand the way the Lord works. What are some of the actions of the Lord on our behalf as described here?

5. Chapter 3:1-13 – How are the Gentiles to be the same as the Jews who come to believe in Christ?

6. Chapter 4:1-6 – What are some things we share with other Christians?

7. The leaders the Lord gives to the Church are for the good of the whole church. In 4:12-16, what should be a goal for all Christians as time goes on?

8. Chapter 4:26-27 – What would happen if we were better at following Paul's advice in these verses?

9. Chapter 5:21 is the theme for the rest of the letter. List one or two instructions pertaining to the following relationships in chapter 5:22-6:9...
