

## Community and Student Engagement - 2017

### House Bill 5

Under House Bill 5 (passed by the 83<sup>rd</sup> Texas Legislature), all school districts are required to evaluate the district's performance and the performance of each campus in regard to community and student engagement. Districts must assign one of four performance ratings – Exemplary, Recognized, Acceptable, or Unacceptable – to the district and each campus for overall performance in the following categories:

- Fine Arts
- Wellness and Physical Education
- Community and Parental Involvement
- 21<sup>st</sup> Century Workforce Development Program
- Second Language Acquisition Program
- Digital learning Environment
- Dropout Prevention Strategies
- Educational Programs for Gifted and Talented Students

The school district and campuses established committees to determine the criteria that were used to evaluate and assign performance ratings. The committees brainstormed and identified various opportunities available to our students and community and a survey was created for each campus. Computations of cumulative totals were used to establish district and campus ratings.

In addition, the school district and each campus are measured for compliance.
