If your daughter wishes to take AP English next year, please refer to the requirements stipulated in the Course Catalogue, one of which is a diagnostic test.

The reading list for the diagnostic test for AP English Language from English 2 is as follows: *The Great Gatsby*, *The Scarlet Letter*, *The Crucible*, and *Huck Finn*. The reading list for the diagnostic test for AP English Literature from English 3 or Contempo/Women's Literature is as follows: *Beowulf*, *Macbeth*, *The Tempest*, *Paradise Lost*, and *Frankenstein*. Please note that the diagnostic tests will be held after school in Room 604 on Thursday, 4 April 2019. The hour-and-a-half exams will start at precisely 3:00 PM. (The students must earn an 80% on the test to qualify.). Also, passing the exams is only one component to be accepted into these classes. Please remember that our AP classes are conducted based on how the College Board wants; they are, therefore, college courses offered to high school students.
