Student Dress Code 2018-19

It is a known fact, and St. Mary's concurs that there is a direct connection between a student's appearance, his attitude and accomplishments in school. Therefore, students are required to dress appropriately for the full school day and at **any function where the student represents the school**. Administration reserves the right to determine whether or not a student's appearance is appropriate.

School Day Dress Code

1. Uniform shirt:
 - Kelly green or black polyester collared uniform shirt available in the Southside Legacy Shop.
 - Undershirts should not be visible under the uniform shirt.
2. Khaki style pants or shorts of tan or light brown color worn at the waist. (NO cargo pants/shorts or jeans)
3. St. Mary's branded hooded sweatshirt, pullover, or lightweight jacket may all be worn **OVER a St. Mary's collared uniform shirt**. Hoods are not to cover the head or face.
4. Athletes may wear a pressed dress shirt, tie, khaki style pants and belt on game day.
5. Shoes are to be in good condition and laces tied. Socks are to be worn. Sandals are not permitted.

Mass Dress Code – NOTE: The 1st All School Mass for the 2018-19 School Year is August 15th

1. **PRESSED** white long sleeve dress shirt tucked in at the waist
2. St. Mary's uniform tie
3. Khaki pants
4. All other requirements above, with the exception of outwear

Gym Dress Code

1. Any St. Mary's t-shirt
2. Athletic shorts
3. Athletic gym shoes worn with socks
4. Recommended t-shirt and shorts may be purchased in the Southside Legacy Shop.
