### Numbers and Operation in Base Ten

\_\_\_ can understand a 3-digit number represents the amount of hundreds, tens and ones.

(2.NBT.1)

\_\_\_ can represent 3 digit numbers that are multiples of 100 with using base-10 blocks. (2.NBT.1a)

\_\_\_ can count to 500; skip count by 5s and 10s past 200; skip count 100s to 900. (2.NBT.2)

\_\_\_ can read and write numbers to at least 600 using numerals (2.NBT.3)

\_\_\_ can write numbers up to 20 using words (number names). (2.NBT.3)

\_\_\_ can read and write numbers in expanded form to 99. (2.NBT.3)

\_\_\_ can compare two 3 digit numbers. (2.NBT.4)

\_\_\_ can add & subtract within 100 using a grid, a number line, or counters. (2.NBT.5)

\_\_\_ can add & subtract within 100 using base-10 blocks, number grids & number lines. (2.NBT.7)

\_\_\_ can mentally add 10 and subtract 10 from a number up to 900. Can mentally add 100 and subtract 100 from a number up to 900. (2.NBT.8)

\_\_\_ can explain addition and subtraction fact strategies such as making 10, near doubles facts, turn around rule for addition, counting up, counting back, etc. (2.NBT.9)

### Operations and Algebraic Thinking

\_\_\_ can add and subtract within 20 to solve one-step word problems involving situations of adding to, taking from, putting together, or taking apart numbers. (2.OA.1)

\_\_\_ can tell the answers to doubles, combinations-of-10 facts, and +/- 0 and +/- 1 facts. (2.OA.2)

\_\_\_ can use manipulatives or count by 2's to determine if a group of objects up to 20 is even or odd. (2.OA.3)

### Measurement and Data

\_\_\_ can measure objects using inches and centimeters. (2.MD.2)

\_\_\_ can represent numbers from 0 through 20 as lengths on a number line. (2.MD.6)

\_\_\_ can tell and write time using analog and digital clocks to the nearest half hour. (2.MD.7)

\_\_\_ can solve word problems involving quarters, dimes, nickels and pennies. (2.MD.8)
