CHS 1:1 Introduction

What Is Changing? Beginning with the 2018-19 school year, Cherokee High School will provide each student with a device such as a laptop computer or tablet to use as a learning tool at school and at home. This device remains the property of Cherokee High School and must be returned on the student's last day enrolled in Cherokee Central Schools, at the end of the school year, or at any time upon request of the school, whichever comes first.

Why the Change? Computer skills are essential in the 21st century. In addition, Cherokee Central Schools is moving to a blended learning model of teaching and learning. Blended learning is a combination of traditional classroom teaching methods such as lecture with web-based or computer-facilitated content and instruction. Blended learning allows students more flexibility; they can work at their own pace and focus on content within each subject that interests them. It also serves multiple learning styles. Blended learning uses quality technology in the classroom to support learning.

Requirements to Receive a Device. Parent/guardian and student must sign and return this agreement.

Expectations:

- Students must bring their computers to class fully charged every day. In the blended learning model, computers are as essential as paper and pencil. Classrooms will not have spare computers available.
- Students must carry their computers in their school-issued backpacks, which are specially designed for this purpose. Students may use this backpack for all their school needs; a second bag should not be necessary.
- Students must abide by the Cherokee High School Acceptable Use Policy.
