## LJH students benefit from learning CAD technology

Students in Ms. Ferguson's 8th grade science class have begun to learn how to use CAD (Computer Assisted Design) software for 3D printing applications.

CAD software is used in many vocations such as engineering, construction, architecture, and the automotive and manufacturing industries.

As a basic task to become familiar with the program, students created tag keychains with their names printed on them.

"It is a good opportunity for students to use skills that scientists use every day," noted Ferguson.

"Measuring length, adjusting and comparing sizes, and problem-solving."

Ferguson looks forward to her students creating models of atoms, working with models of the earth's changes, and tackling real-world design challenges.

LJH teachers in other content areas are also looking forward to using the software and 3D printer for exploring geometry, making physical maps of an area, and using the design process to create objects related to stories they read in class.
