Boys & Girls Golf – Mead Boys were 3rd at their league match played at Downriver last week. **Zane Mularski** shot 70 and finished 2nd. The Girls were 1st – 4 strokes better than Lewis & Clark – **Cami Culp** (74) and **Charlotte Bloom** (82) were 3rd & 4th respectively.

The Final GSL Match of the season is Wednesday at Deer Park. After that, the top three Greater Spokane League teams and qualifying golfers will be paired with golfers and teams from the Mid-Columbia Conference for the District 8 Golf Tournament, May 13 & 14 at MeadowWood Golf Course. Qualifying golfers will advance to their respective State Tournaments. The Girls State Tournament Site is Hangman Valley Golf Course and the Boys will be at The Creek at Qualchan, May 21 & 22.

Baseball – Mead earned the #2 4A District 8 Tournament seed after taking two from Rogers to finish GSL regular season play, last week. Saturday, we hosted the Chiawana Riverhawks in a District 8 Baseball first round game. The Boys defeated the Riverhawks 5-2 to advance to the semifinal, Tuesday at Richland. **Dayton Wells** pitched a complete game, allowing just 1 earned run and striking out 6. In the 4th, Chiawana scored on 2 hits and a Mead error, but the Panthers got the run back in the bottom of the 4th without a hit. **Thomas McKenna** led off with a walk and **Izaiah deJong**, running for **McKenna**, stole second and came around to score when the throw to second was high and got past the center fielder. **Wells** struck out the side in the 5th. **Dylan Jordan** singled with one out in the Panther 5th and **Marshall Miacolo** doubled. **Braeden Cordes** singled on the next pitch to score **Jordan** and **Miacolo** and Mead led 3-1. **McKenna's** triple in the 6th plated **Elijah Hainline** who walked to lead off the inning and **Dalen Simbler's** sacrifice fly scored **McKenna** for the Panther's 5th run. Game time in Richland Tuesday is 5:00.

Softball – The girls finished league play last week with a win over Ferris, 13-1 and a couple of tough losses to University, 9-7 and Lewis & Clark, 2-1. We finished 6th in the GSL (4th place 4A) and will play at Richland in a 1st round District 8 Softball Tournament game - Tuesday, May 7th at 5:00 pm.

Boys & Girls Track – The race for the Boys Track Title came down to a single point last Thursday at Central Valley. The Bears edged the Panthers 73-72 for the GSL trophy. Mead Boys finished the season 8-1 with their 114-27 win over North Central. The Girls split with the Bears and Indians, defeating North Central 76-74. All 10 GSL schools sent their JV teams to the Mead Twilight Invite on Friday and both the Panther Boys' & Girls' teams placed 2nd. The GSL Championships are Thursday & Friday, at Central Valley. Qualifiers advance to next weekend's District 8 Track Meet in Richland.

Soccer – the boys lost their tie-breaker game to Lewis & Clark on Monday, 5-0. Mead finished 3rd in league with a 6-3 record and was 8-7-1 overall.

Lacrosse – The Mead Lacrosse Team finished their regular season by winning 4 of their last 6 games and qualified for the WHSBLA 4A Playoffs. They play Saturday against Curtis. Good Luck Boys!
