4. Can you show me some samples of my child's work over this last quarter?
5. What is my child's reading level? How is it measured?
6. Does my child complete work on time?
7. How is my child's attitude in class?
8. How does my child relate to other children in the class?
9. What specific activities can we do at home to help my child's progress?
10. What can I do to help keep the lines of communications open from home to school throughout the year?
