THE PFTs ARE COMING! THE PFTs ARE COMING! On Late Start Tuesday and Wednesday, April 16-17, @ 7:30am, the California Physical Fitness tests will be conducted at the SPHS gym and field. The following students should report to the gym for testing: 9th grade fall, winter and spring athletes who are not enrolled in a PE class; 9th grade students not enrolled in a PE class; 10th - 11th grade students who have not passed five out of the six PFTs; and 10th - 11th grade students who have not yet taken any of the California PFTs. Students who have met the graduation requirement of 20 credits in PE, and have passed five out of the six PFTs, will not be required to remain enrolled in PE in the 2019-2020 school year.
