NDB seeks a motivated, enthusiastic and resourceful Art Teacher for the 2019-2020 academic year, who will share the responsibility in the academic development of students and guidance in spiritual, social, co-curricular, and extracurricular activities. This is a part time position teaching Art, levels 1-4 with potential to grow/expand into a full time position depending on additional skills and or expertise. The Art Teacher reports directly to the Associate Principal.

Description

The Art teacher is responsible for the development and implementation of a well-defined and rigorous 4-year, 2-D art curriculum, including but not limited to these year-long courses: Art I, Art II, Art III, Art IV, Independent Study Art, and AP Studio Art. The department is committed to emphasizing personal growth and expression while supporting students' development of technique and mastery. The art teacher is also responsible for the care of the art studio, and for ordering appropriate equipment and supplies that support the intended curriculum. A yearly competitive all-school art show caps the year's work and is administrated collaboratively by all art teachers. There is an expectation that all art teachers display current student work in the VPA gallery and other sites around the campus throughout the school year.
