Third Grade Donation List

While all necessary materials are provided for your child, there are some items that are frequently used and need to be replenished frequently. If you are willing to help by donating these items, it would be greatly appreciated.

- Black Expo dry erase markers
- Copy paper (white)
- Kleenex tissue boxes
- Clorox wipes
- 0.7 mm mechanical pencils and lead
- Ticonderoga #2 pencils

We also recommend students have access to the following items at home: Crayons, colored pencils, washable markers, glue, and scissors

Strongly Recommended Supply List for Students

A plastic pencil box with the following items in it at all times:

- Sharpened #2 Ticonderoga pencils
- Expo dry erase marker (black only)
- Box of Crayons (no larger than 24 count)
- Large pink eraser
- Yellow highlighter
- Blue ballpoint pen
- Earbuds in a ziplock bag
- Optional:* 0.7 mm mechanical pencils and lead

*Students DO NOT need scissors, markers, or colored pencils in their pencil boxes. Students DO NOT need binders.

Students also need:

- 1 single subject spiral notebook
- 1 durable multiple subject/thicker spiral notebook (or 2 more single subject for math notes)

Fourth Grade Donation List

Requested student supplies:

- Headset for iPad use. Durable ones that will last through the year.
- a 2 inch**, 3-ring binder.
- 4 2-pocket folders, no prongs, solid color. Folder should have holes to place in binder.
- 1 single-subject spiral notebook
- pencil box (about 8.5"x5"x2.5" ONLY. Items below MUST FIT IN BOX.)
 - Block eraser (Magic Rub erasers work best)**
 - 3 correction pens, any color (except black)
 - Pencil sharpener with shaving reservoir
 - Student scissors- optional
 - Box of 12 Crayola Colored Pencils
 - Box of 16 or 24 Crayola Crayons
- 1 box/doz+ of Ticonderoga #2 pencils for classroom supply**
- 1 pack of 3 Expo dry erase chisel tip markers, BLACK only**

**Leave in package. These will be held in class and distributed to your student as needed throughout the year.

 - Student scissors- optional
 - Box of 16 or 24 Crayola Crayons
- 1 box/doz+ of Ticonderoga #2 pencils for classroom supply
- 1 pack of 3 Expo dry erase chisel tip markers, BLACK or BLUE only

 - 16 count box of Crayola crayons
 - Colored pencils (optional)
- 1 box of Ticonderoga #2 pencils (NO lead pencils)*
- 1 pack of 5 Expo dry erase chisel tip markers, BLACK only*
- 3 packs of glue sticks*
